West Cumbria Family Support Worker



Cumbria Alcohol and Drug Advisory Service (CADAS) have an exciting vacancy for a family support worker in the west of the county.

Our family worker will support families over an extended period of time (up to 6 months) when they are referred to us because of parental substance use and its effects on the family, especially the children.

We are looking for someone passionate about working in West Cumbrian communities who has the skills to support all members of a family, from parents and caregivers to teens and primary school-aged children.

This will be a home-working position with the majority of work taking place out in the community. The role covers the whole of West Cumbria from Millom to Silloth.

The salary for this 37.5 hour role is £20,377pa. We are open to job share applicants – please give us a call if you would like to talk this through before making an application. This is a fixed term contract of 2 years, but we are hoping that this pilot will be so successful that we will be able to continue and expand it in years to come.

This is a “regulated” position and you would be required to undertake an enhanced DBS check with a vetting and barring check for both the adult and the children’s workforce.
